STATEMENT OF PRINCIPAL

The Canadian Equestrian Federation (C.E.F), the National Federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all competitions under its jurisdiction. The C.E.F is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities.
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment.
- Ensuring that owners, trainers, exhibitors and their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose.
- Providing for the continuous well being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure.
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare.
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices.
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competitions.
- Reviewing, revising, and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a reasonable person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibiting procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive, nor inhumane.

The 20th ANNUAL WILD ROSE ARABIAN & HALF- ARABIAN/ANGLO- ARABIAN HORSE SHOW is a recognized member horse show and is governed by the Canadian Equestrian Federation.

This show is also approved by the International Arabian Horse Association.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

All classes in this show will be governed by the current C.E.F. Rules and Amendments and the current I.A.H.A. Handbook and amendments. Therefore, it meets all requirements for eligibility of National and Regional Championship classes and Achievement Awards points. In the case of any discrepancy, I.A.H.A. rules will prevail and if not covered, then the C.E.F. rules will apply. The Show Committee reserves the right to decide on any rule not covered by C.E.F. and/or I.A.H.A.

All decisions by the Show Committee are final.

Any horse entered in any class is required to pay the drug testing fee and may be selected for equine medication control testing.

Grooms entering the ring are to appear neat, clean and suitably attired in the opinion of the Show Committee (i.e. unmarked smock).

No person other than the officials, steward, attendants on duty, and the Judge of the class may enter the ring without the permission of the Judge.

Exhibitors are responsible for reporting all entries to the Gate Attendant ten minutes before each respective class is called for showing and must enter the ring promptly when called. Those **not** ready when called **will not** be allowed to enter the ring to compete. No fees will be refunded.

Horses **shall not** be punished unnecessarily or severely anywhere on the Show Grounds. Rules regarding cruelty and abuse are covered by the C.E.F. Rule Book and will be enforced.

Any Exhibitor using a wrong back number or having no number may be excused or disqualified from the class at the discretion of the Judge of the class. No fees will be refunded. Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise rings.

Upon any act of discourtesy or disobedience to the officials on the part of the owner, groom, rider, driver, or handler, the owner may forfeit his entry fee and such action will be reported to C.E.F. The Show Management reserves to itself the power to remove any person or horse from the Show or the Show Grounds without being liable for compensation.

Course/patterns will be posted at least **one** hour before the class at the Show Office and in an area designated by the Show Committee.

All horses artificially, improperly or unfairly prepared or tampered with before coming into the Show Arena will be disqualified. If it is ascertained that an **exhibitor** has made or caused to be made a false statement in regard to any animal or article exhibited or if any **exhibitor** shall attempt to interfere with the Judge in the performance of his/her duties, that exhibitor shall be excluded from competing or exhibiting. In case of any animal being disqualified the winner of the next succeeding prize shall take the prize that has been awarded to such animal and lowest prize in the class shall go to the reserve number.

Halter, Trail, and Reining Classes - Weather permitting all halter, trail, and reining classes will be held in the outdoor arena.

Juniors are strongly advised to wear hard hats until just before they enter the show ring.

**IMPORTANT * IMPORTANT * IMPORTANT * IMPORTANT
PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING!!**

1. Please read all rules and forms before completing. Errors are costly to everyone.
2. Full entry fees must accompany all entries.
3. Entries must be complete and include copies of the following:
 - a) **Current registration papers** - front & back for each horse entered.
 - b) Copy of **lease agreement** or **contract of sale** (if applicable).
 - c) Copy of **membership card** from **I.A.H.A.** and **C.E.F.** for each owner, rider, handler, driver.
- Seniors and Youth.
 - d) Copy of **C.E.F. Amateur card** (if applicable).

Entries will be considered incomplete if submitted without copies of registration papers and membership cards.

Collect calls will be made to exhibitors by the Show Secretary if deemed necessary to clarify any entry.

ELIGIBILITY:

The following **are eligible** to compete at this C.E.F. & I.A.H.A. recognized show:

1. All riders, drivers, owners, lessees, agents, or trainers who are a member of C.E.F. and I.A.H.A.
2. Membership in only the International Arabian Horse Association **does not** entitle exhibitors to show at C.E.F. recognized show (except **handlers** showing **only** in **IN- HAND BREEDING** classes).
3. Any **individual** participating in this show **must** be a member of an I.A.H.A. Region member association - in good standing. Entries will NOT be accepted unless accompanied by a copy of the I.A.H.A. membership card with legible number.
4. Temporary membership can be purchased for C.E.F. and I.A.H.A. These memberships would only be in effect for this show and do not carry forward to any other show nor with any yearly award points. **Temporary memberships are NOT allowed at the Regional or National level.**
5. All exhibitors over the age of eighteen (19 & over) competing in **Amateur** classes must be eligible for Amateur status as described in the C.E.F. 1998 Rule Book. They must also have a current C.E.F. Amateur Membership card. This membership **must** be applied & paid for separately each year.
6. Any person who **has not** reached their 18th birthday is regarded as an Amateur and is called a YOUTH. Youth exhibitors must also have a current membership in C.E.F. & I.A.H.A. if over the age of 10 years.
7. All horses entered in this show must be registered with the Canadian Arabian Horse Registry, the Arabian Horse Registry of America or the International Arabian Horse Association. **Any horse registered with the Canadian Partbred Registry must obtain a CPAR permit from I.A.H.A. and a copy of this certificate must accompany the entry form.**
8. Combined ownership is **not** allowed in Amateur Owner classes unless all owners are members of the immediate family.

RULES & REGULATIONS

ENTRIES:

1. Entries must be postmarked no later than June 30th, 2000. The Show Committee will accept post-dated cheques dated to June 30th, 2000 encouraging early entries.

AFTER July 6th, 2000: All entries will be considered a late entry and will pay a late entry fee of \$25.00 per HORSE no matter what date the post mark is on the envelope.

This rule is new this year and will be strictly enforced. No exceptions will be allowed.

Post entries for all classes will be accepted up to the session before the class being entered at regular fee. No post entry fee will be charged if the horse was entered into the show prior to July 6th, 2000.

2. Management agrees to cancel and refund entry & stall fees on any horse unable to show providing notice, in writing, is received by the Show Secretary on or before July 6th, 2000. A \$20.00 processing charge will be retained.

Exhibitors canceling their entries for any reason after July 6th, 2000 will forfeit entry fees unless a suitable Veterinarian Certificate attesting to illness or injury is received, in writing, by the Show Secretary before 7:30 a.m. on Saturday July 15th, 2000. A \$20.00 processing fee will be retained.

3. The Show Committee reserves the right to cancel or combine any class with three (3) entries or less at the closing date of entries. If a class is cancelled, entry fees will be refunded. Large classes may be split at the discretion of the Show Management, with each section run back to back. Classes split by Age Grouping may be combined if the numbers do not warrant running them split.

4. Exhibitors will be called **collect** if entries are incomplete, not correct, or as deemed necessary by the Entries Secretary.

5. There will be a **\$20.00** charge for any **Returned Cheque**.

6. The Show Steward shall have the full power to act for and on behalf of the Show Committee during the entire show.

7. The Show Committee reserves the right to add to, amend, or decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make any necessary alterations in the prize list or show program.

STABLING:

1. Stabling will be available at 12:00 NOON - Friday, July 14th, 2000. Stalls must be vacated no later than midnight on July 15th, 2000.

2. The first bale of bedding will be provided.

3. Exhibitors will not move from their assigned stalls without permission.

4. Feed and bedding is available from Amberlea Meadows - **but is limited**.

5. Veterinarian and farrier services will be available as posted in the Show Office.

6. **Extended stabling** - contact Amberlea Meadows directly. 24 hour advance notice required. Call (780) 955- 7608 or Fax: (780) 955- 7755.

I.A.H.A. EQUITATION MEDAL CLASSES, SPECIFICATIONS

I.A.H.A. HUNTER SEAT - NOT TO JUMP MEDAL:

1. Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to Dec. 31st.
2. Following the rail work, two or more individual tests from C.E.F., Article B2102 and Articles F309 and F311 shall be required.
3. To receive a medal in this class, three competitors with proper appointments must compete.
(see below)

I.A.H.A. SADDLE SEAT MEDAL:

1. Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to Dec. 31st.
2. Following the rail work, two or more individual tests from C.E.F. F408 with requirements 1- 15, Article F410.
3. To receive a medal in this class, three competitors with proper appointments must compete.
(see below)

I.A.H.A. STOCK SEAT MEDAL:

1. Open to Juniors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday prior to Dec. 31st.
2. All contestants are required to perform both the rail work and the entire Stock Horse Pattern as outlined in the C.E.F., Article F1701 and Article F1505.
3. Dropping of bits is optional with the Judge, but if called for in the ring, assistance, if necessary may be had from one of the ring officials. Reins shall not be removed from the horse's neck while inspecting bits.
4. To receive a medal in this class, three competitors with proper appointments must compete.
(see below)
5. In I.A.H.A. Stock Seat Medal Class an off pattern rider is not eligible to win a medal.

Article 1134 - *For all I.A.H.A. Medal classes with less than three (3) competitors, I.A.H.A. Medal points will be earned. - refer to article 1134.6) For all other class specifications refer to the current C.E.F. Rules and the current I.A.H.A. Handbook.*

RULES REGARDING PROTESTS:

A protest at a C.E.F. recognized competition, other than those specific matters covered in division rules, must comply with the following:

1. A protest is eligible only if made by the officiating Judge, an owner, lessee, trainer, competitor, or authorized agent in the Division in which the question arises. A protest must be made in writing and addressed to the Show Secretary of the competition at which the matter under consideration occurs, must be signed, and must be accompanied by a deposit of \$50.00 in cash or certified cheque. A copy of the protest must be sent to the C.E.F. National Office and applicable Provincial Office.
2. A protest must contain a specific statement of an alleged violation of a rule or of a condition of a class and must give the full name and, if possible, the address of the alleged violator. The make of the protest must be prepared to substantiate the protest or charge by personal testimony, sworn statements, witnesses or other relevant evidence.
3. A protest must be filed within forty eight hours (48) of the completion of the class concerned.
4. For further information regarding protests and appeals, refer to C.E.F. 1998 Rule book.
